

ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR SILVIU-COSMIN MOLDOVAN**1975 – 2020**

“George Emil Palade” University of Medicine, Pharmacy, Science and Technology of Târgu Mureş has been deeply affected by the untimely death of **Associate Professor Silviu-Cosmin Moldovan**, Vice-Dean of the Faculty of Medicine in English.

Associate Professor Silviu-Cosmin Moldovan (PhD) was born on August 9 1975, in Târgu-Mureş, and graduated from the Faculty of Medicine, University of Medicine and Pharmacy of Târgu-Mureş, in 1999.

After graduation, in 2000, he started to work as an intern, and in 2004 he began his residency in pathological anatomy at the Emergency County Hospital of Târgu-Mureş and continued his professional activity as medical specialist and then as senior physician in pathological anatomy at the Emergency County Hospital of Târgu-Mureş.

He embarked upon his teaching career in 2002 at the University of Medicine and Pharmacy of Târgu Mureş as teaching assistant (2002-2004). He showed great passion and dedication and his merits were rewarded by a series of promotions, from assistant lecturer (2004-2012), to lecturer (2012-2016) within the Discipline of Histology, and then, since 2016, as Associate Professor within the Discipline of Applied Simulation in Medicine.

He was a member of several scientific organisations, such as the Society for Simulation Applied to Medicine, a founding member of the Romanian Society for Simulation Applied to Medicine, a member in the editorial board of several medical journals, editorial manager of *The Journal of Critical Care Medicine*, as well as manager of projects in research, further training and institutional development.

Associate Professor Silviu-Cosmin Moldovan was highly appreciated by the entire academic community for his professional skills and achievements and by whole generations of students who benefitted from his remarkable talent as a teacher and as a person close to their hearts.

The academic community would like to express its profound regret and sincerest condolences to the bereaved family, assuring them of its unreserved compassion.
